

Minutes of Meeting of the Air Quality Monitoring Committee held on 20.03.2019 in Committee Room, HP Secretariat, Shimla (H.P.)– 171004' at 11.00 AM, in compliance to the Hon'ble NGT orders vide OA No. 681/2018 in the matter of News Item Published In 'The Times of India' Authored by Shri. Vishwa Mohan Titled "NCAP with Multiple Timelines to Clear Air in 102 Cities to be released around August 15".

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Dr. R.K Pruthi, IAS, Member Secretary (MS), Himachal Pradesh State Pollution Control Board (HPSPCB), welcomed the Committee members as well as Officials of State Government. The List of Officials who attended the meeting is enclosed as **Annexure-I**.

Thereafter, Dr. R.K Pruthi, MS, HPSPCB, apprised that the Action Plans of seven non-attainment cities have been approved by CPCB with following recommendations:-

Source Identification	Industries, Road Dust, Vehicles, Open Burning, Construction activities	Major sources identified except Domestic Fuel
Source Apportionment (SA) and Emission Inventory (EI)	EI & SA not quantified	Carryout EI & SA Estimates
Public Awareness and Complaint Redressal Mechanism	Public complaints redressal mechanism not outlined	Detail proposal to be worked out

Following decisions were taken upon deliberation:-

- The copy of approval as received from Central Pollution Control Board in OA No. 681/2018 shall be sent to all the Committee members.
- All the concerned Departments will execute their Action Plans in the non-attainment cities and will submit their progress report on monthly basis in soft as well as hard copy.
- The Graded Response Action Plan (GRAP) of CPCB may be circulated to all the Air Quality Monitoring Committee members.
- For better disposal of complaints, software/tab may be developed to register the complaints which are to be addressed by District Level Monitoring Committees and Regional Officer; the proposal for same may be discussed with NIC.
- The Source Apportionment/Emission Inventory study will be conducted by the State Board through IIT Kanpur. The State Board shall invite the proposal from IIT Kanpur and same shall be discussed in next AQMC meeting.


- All the concerned Departments are requested to prioritize the implementation of proposed activities through their field offices under the Action Plan (month-wise) and progress report w.r.t. the same will be submitted by the end of Every Month through the Monitoring Committee Constituted vide Notification No. STE-E(3)-22/2018-loose, Dated 07.03.2019 Thereafter, the AQMC meeting shall be convened during first week of the following month to review the progress.
- To address the issue of domestic fuel identification, the Director Food & Civil Supply may be adopted as co-opted Member of Air Quality Monitoring Committee.

The Member Secretary, HPSPCB informed that all the Committee Members shall be provided a copy of approval as received from the Central Pollution Control Board w.r.t. aforementioned NGT matter.

Further, all the designated members are requested to remain present in person in the scheduled meetings rather than their representatives so that the directions of the Hon'ble NGT are complied with in letter & spirits.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks by Member Secretary, HP State Pollution Control Board to all members of Environment Monitoring Committee.


