

Minutes of the 7th Air Quality Monitoring Committee (AQMC) meeting held on 26.04.2019 at Committee Room, HP Secretariat, Shimla at 11.30 AM, under the Chairmanship of Sh. R.D. Dhiman, Addl. Chief Secretary, Government of Himachal Pradesh.

In compliance to the Hon'ble NGT orders dated 08.10.2018 vide OA No. 681/2018 in the matter of News Item published in "The Times of India" authored by Sh. Vishwa Mohan titled "NCAP" with multiple timelines to clear Air in 102 cities to be released around 15th August. A meeting was held on 26.04.2019 at 11.30 AM, at Committee Room, HP Secretariat, Shimla

At the outset, Dr. R. K. Pruthi, Member Secretary, HPSPCB, welcomed the Chairman and members of Air quality Monitoring Committee (AQMC). The List of Officials attended the meeting is enclosed as **Annexure-I**.

After a brief introduction of members, the Member Secretary, HPSPCB briefed the Hon'ble Chairman about the various issues pertaining to NGT matter in OA No. 681/2018.

He further informed that the Action plans submitted w.r.t. Non-attainment Cities have been approved by CPCB with three recommendations.

The Hon'ble Chairman directed all the concerned Departments to ensure timely implementation of the approved Action Plans and submit monthly report incorporating physical and financial progress in the report.

To address the recommendation of CPCB, following points are hereby included in the action plan of Non- attainment cities:

During the meeting it was decided that:

1. The department of food and civil supply will supply the information whether all the households in these cities are using LPG fuel as a domestic fuel or not.
2. Directions will be issued to the Industrial association, HIMUDA, HPPWD, HPSEB and Labour Contractors to ensure that migratory labour use LPG gas as domestic fuel.
3. The forest department will provide the 10000 plants in each Non-attainment city to the State Board during this monsoon season.
4. The PWD Department will ensure the timely execution of their action points and funds for the same will be managed at their own level. The NHAI will also be called for next AQMC meeting to discuss the issue of road dust in Non-attainment cities.
5. For the complaint redressal mechanism, the State Board will work out with NIC and option through e-samadhan portal will also be explored.


Dr. Mukesh Sharma, Professor, IIT Kanpur made a detailed presentation to AQMC on the proposal of Source Apportionment study of seven Non- Attainment Cities in the State of Himachal Pradesh. He further explained that for the emission inventory, the source shall be categorised into three parts : (i) Area source i.e. Hotels/ Restaurants, Domestic Cooking, MSW Burning, Construction/Demolition, Concrete Batching, Road Dust, Industries, DG Sets, Aircrafts, Biomass Burning, Fly Ash, Cremation point source (ii) Point source i.e. Power Plants, Industries, Incinerator, DG sets (iii) Line source i.e. Vehicles.

After detailed discussion on the proposal of IIT Kanpur for study on "Emission Inventory & Source Apportionment Study of Non-attainment cities" the following decisions were taken by AQMC:

1. The proposal for study of Emission Inventory & Source Apportionment of seven Non-attainment cities is approved by the AQMC subject to the condition that financial aspect of the study shall be below Rs. 2.25 Crore.
2. After receiving revised proposal, the State Board will award the study to IIT Kanpur on "Emission Inventory & Source Apportionment of seven Non-attainment cities of HP".
The State Board to ensure that the study is completed within prescribed time.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the chair.


